The multiplication event was prepared in advance by preparing the event agenda, invitation to participate, registration of participants by filling in the online form provided by the project coordinator Eliza SOTIRESCU, preparation of materials that were presented at the event (powerpoint presentations, printing the toolkit for each participant, presentation of the project site and the platform <https://moodle.l-cloud.eu/>, where interested teachers can take the training course L-Cloud WEBINAR COURSE: CLOUD EDUCATION LEADERS, but also the presentation of the Erasmus program and its benefits in the development of the institution, activities important that led to the realization of the three intellectual products.

The agenda of the event aimed at presenting all the activities carried out within the project, the objectives, the partners, the detailed approach of the three intellectual products: IO1. Develop Guidelines for Skills and Competences for Adaptive Education Cloud Leaders, IO2. Develop a Qualification Framework for Education Cloud Leaders based on Skills and Competence, IO3 Design a course for developing adaptive education cloud leaders. The materials presented at the multiplication event were made by the project coordinator Eliza SOTIRESCU and included the stages of making the three intellectual products, the detailed presentation of each product made in the project, their innovative character, the competence framework in the profile of adaptive cloud education.

The participants in the event: teachers, school principals, computer scientists, school inspectors appreciated the novelty and the added value of the project products in the context of the COVID 19 pandemic in which the

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school is located, the transition from face-to-face learning to online learning.

Please describe the profile of the participants who attended, and their involvement in the event.

The event was attended by 30 teachers from the Alexandria schools and high schools in Teleorman County, school unit directors, as well as inspectors from the Teleorman County Inspectorate.

The participants gave positive feedback and they appreciated the work and intellectual products developed within the project.

The participants in the multiplication event expressed their desire to participate and to be certified in the online course L-Cloud - Developing Tomorrow's Cloud Education Leaders being an opportunity, but also a challenge in their professional training.

The participants of the event on 03.07.2020 are 54% of teachers of different disciplines: foreign languages, computer science, primary school teachers, Romanian language, mathematics, physics, physical education, religion, 30% of the participants were inspectors from the Teleorman County School Inspectorate and 13% were teachers with managers in kindergartens, schools and high schools, and 3% were auxiliary teaching staff in schools: computer scientists.

The event was very well organized, the presentation of the project, the three intellectual products made in the project are beneficial for each teacher.

The principals and inspectors participating in the event were aware of the potential benefits for learning, teaching, administration and management that cloud computing offers and said that a pedagogical change is needed so that teachers can use new technologies in the teaching-learning process to improve the quality of education and to transform the way schools are run and managed.

Reception and socialization were of high quality, catering was good, it contained coffee, tea, water, soft drinks, and lunch.


